

## When to use this form

This form should be used by a person who is normally selfemployed in the United Kingdom (UK) and is going to work temporarily in another country within the European Economic Area (EEA). The form will enable HMRC to determine which Member State's social security legislation will apply.

If you normally work in two or more EEA countries form CA8421 should be completed instead.

# **EEA** nationals

If you are an EEA national, social security liability is determined by EC Regulation 883/04.

### **Non-EEA** nationals

If you are not an EEA national, but are legally resident in a European Union Member State, social security legislation is determined by EC Regulation 1408/71.

# **Further information**

If you are subject to UK National Insurance legislation:

- Form A1 (or E101 if Regulation 1408/71 applies) will be sent to you.
- We may notify the competent authorities in the country in which you are working that you remain subject to UK legislation.
- You should continue to pay UK National Insurance contributions.

If you are subject to the social security legislation of another country we will let you know why.

You should notify us immediately of any change in employment circumstances, particularly if you decide not to work abroad or stop working abroad before the intended date.

We may check your circumstances throughout the period to ensure that the conditions under which you remain subject to UK legislation are still met.

## How we use your information
